Expert Agent's office is a former chapel located in the centre of Frome, Somerset.

Frome, Jenson Button's home, is a thriving market town, 12 miles south of Bath. In recent years, the town centre has been rejuvenated by a proactive town manager and is now full of classy, individual shops, and cafes. If you bring partners or family members, there is a lot to keep them entertained for the day. For a longer stay, [Longleat House and safari park](#) are 3 miles away. [Center Parks](#) is in Longleat Forest, again, 3 miles away.

Allow 2 hours drive from Heathrow and 2.5 hours drive from the M42/M5 junction south of Birmingham.

Public Transport

Rail: Frome has a railway station but despite being on the London to Penzance main line, the fast trains don't stop. You'll have to change at Westbury. There are trains from Bristol Temple Meads.

Air: Frome is about 45 mins by car from Bristol Airport. A taxi will cost about £50 each way.

Driving Tips:

Everyone's got a Tom Tom or similar these days so we've not given turn-by-turn instructions.

From the south east: take the M3, not the M4. You'll avoid any built-up areas and will get a much better trip. Your sat nav will guide you along the A303 to Stonehenge then to the A36 towards Warminster and Bath. Take the A362 to Frome,

Once in Frome: follow A362 towards Radstock from the mini roundabout above the town centre and take the first proper road right (with Mike's Sandwich Engineering on the corner). That's South Parade. You'll pass The Old Meeting House on your left, park in the Pay & Display car park (£3 per day) 100 yards down at the bottom of South Parade.

Accommodation:

Sadly there are no decent hotels, pubs with accommodation or bed and breakfast places in the town centre.

We Recommend:

[The Somerset Arms, Maiden Bradley](#) - 6 miles south of Frome. They've just won a big food award.

[The Angel Inn, Upton Scudamore](#) - 5 miles East of Frome. Always excellent.

[Premier Travel Inn & "Frome Flyer" pub](#) - 2 miles from town on the Frome bypass. The Frome Flyer is named after Jenson Button and it is a very smart, if rather artificial modern roadside pub built within the last couple of years.

[Babington House](#), the celebrities' hangout is 3 miles away. If you are bringing your partner and fancy a bit of treat, call them for a midweek deal and mention that you are working with Pete MacKay and Mike Griffiths – you might get a better rate.

If you're really stuck, [Travelodge](#) have 2 scruffy local sites – Beckington & Warminster.
